Position:

Full-time position, late April through mid-July, applications due March 9, 2012, with some variation in the starting and ending date depending upon the availability of the person hired. You will have the opportunity to assist AJSA staff with planning four regional Classic shows and the National Classic in Lima, Ohio, as well as help lead the AJSA board of trustees, write press releases and articles, take photos and video, and facilitate web updates.
