<u>Letter of Intent to Purchase the Simmental Way Property</u>. Discussion led by Bob Lanting with Ms. Johnson and Ms. Pates consulting. Items Presented.

- > \$4,000,000 (Four million) offered
- > ASA take responsibility for demolition
- ASA applies and pays the cost to apply for North 19th access
- > \$25,000 earnest money with 45-day due diligence / 6-month due diligence pertaining to the North 19th access

First Draft of Counteroffer. Discussion led by Bob Lanting with Ms. Johnson and Ms. Pates consulting.

Items Discussed.

- > \$4,000,000 (Four million) asking price includes all structures, infrastructures and additional appurtenances
- Demolition by buyer
- ASA applies for North 19th access; buyer bears all costs
- > Stained glass window and wooden beams
- > Due diligence period

Moved Tim Smith seconded Fred Schuetze to present the following in the counteroffer:

- ➤ \$4,000,000 (four million) asking price
- \$25,000 earnest money (45 days due diligence)
 - Termination of agreement within the 45 days due diligence earnest money refundable
 - At the end of 45 days if additional time is needed/agreed; an additional \$25,000 earnest money required
 - If North 19th access is denied, the second \$25,000 earnest money will be refunded.
 - All earnest money is applied to the purchase price
- Demolition responsibility of buyer
- Information and/or items discovered during the due diligence period become the property of ASA
- ASA will continue to accept backup offers
- > Stained glass window will be removed and seller will board up window opening.
- Reserve the rights to the wooden beams if and when the building is demolished

Motion carried.

Review and working through the details during the initial process to flush out details for the full-term purchase agreement. Consensus from board members is for Trustees to waive the 10-day notification for full board meeting(s) when needed.
